Anouilh play to open Kanata series

Four three-act plays will be staged in the auditorium of the Earl of March High School during the coming season by the Kanata Theatre Group.

The opening production will be "Ring Around the Moon" by Jean Anouilh. It will be presented Nov. 18-20 under the direction of Laurence Thornton. Auditions for the Golden Goose by Jean Feather of Ottawa are slated for Nov. 6 and 7. It will be directed by Dewi Williams.

The second play, planned for Feb. 12-13, will be A. Witch's First Birthday, by Robert Neil Porter. The director will be James MacIntosh.

The final play, yet to be selected, will be presented May 21 as part of the annual Kanata May Fair.

A workshop program will be conducted for members wishing to gain experience in various aspects of theatre. Three one-act plays will be used for this purpose.

Anouilh play for Kanata

The Kanata Theatre Group launches its fourth season with Jean Anouilh's play Ring Around the Moon, to be performed Nov. 18, 19 and 20 in the new Earl of March High School. Casting dates for the production are Sept. 13, 18 and 19.

Three other plays, as yet unannounced, will be presented a teenage production on Mar. 3 and 4, and the remaining productions on Mar. 16, 17, 18 and May 11, 12, and 13, all in Earl of March School.

The group will also do three plays for children: Golden Goose, by Ottawa author Jean Feather, Nov. 6 and 7; A Witch's First Birthday, by Robert Neil Porter, Feb. 12 and 13; and a third play, not yet selected, May 21.
