Calgary in wartime, five women cope with the pressures of a remote conflict. A play that captures precisely the texture of ordinary hopes and despair.

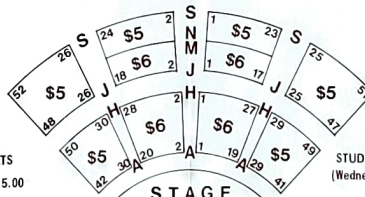
